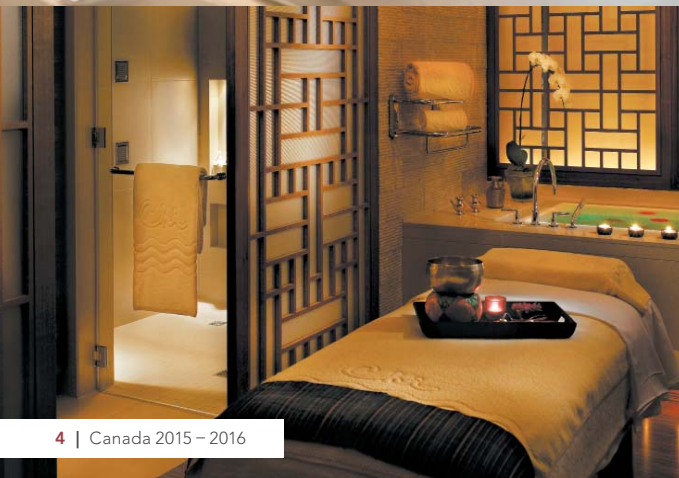
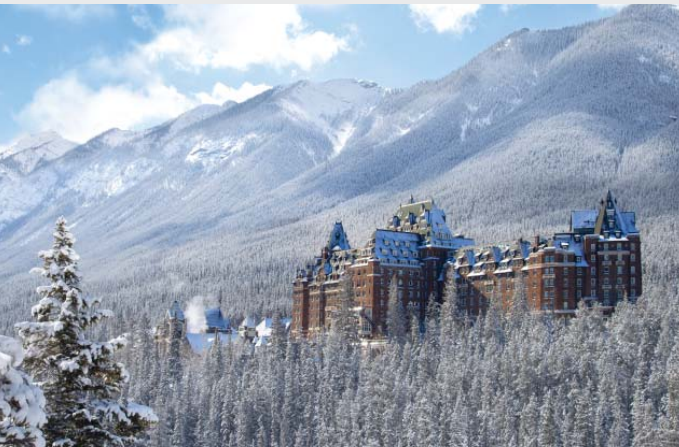

LOCAL FAVORITES IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

VANCOUVER ART GALLERIES

The Vancouver Art Gallery features innovative contemporary art displays and significant pieces of historical art. Enjoy the works of British Columbian artists as well as those of major international icons. For Aboriginal art, visit the Bill Reid Gallery of Northwest Coast Art or the Museum of Anthropology and see the towering totem poles, beautifully displayed indoors as well as outdoors on the museum grounds. Granville Island is one of the best places in the city to discover original artwork. Explore artist studios to view glassblowing, printmaking, and wood carving. The renowned Emily Carr University of Art and Design features three public galleries.

VICTORIA CITY OF GARDENS

The gardens in Victoria are renowned for their beautiful floral displays and awe-inspiring grounds. One of the most famous is Butchart Gardens. This formal garden sits on 55 acres and is open year-round. Explore the rose garden, with more than 2,500 roses, or relax by the lily-pad pool in the Italian garden. In winter the gardens are alight with dazzling Christmas lights and displays. Visit the Victoria Butterfly Gardens, home to 6,000 butterflies that fly freely within a lush, tropical greenhouse. Wander among orchids and exotic plants and see colorful creatures such as flamingos, Australian whistling tree ducks, and red-eared slider turtles.

WHISTLER OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

Whistler Village is a pedestrian-friendly village that bustles with excitement year-round. Enjoy great restaurants and quaint shops or relax at the spa. In the winter, Whistler Blackcomb attracts skiers and snowboarders from around the world. CULTURAL FESTIVALS

Alberta offers a host of fun festivals featuring music, food, theater, and rodeo events. In Calgary, the world-renowned Calgary Stampede is North America's premier rodeo and Western festival. Film enthusiasts can attend the Calgary International Film Festival, which showcases international and Canadian cinema and offers screenings of over 200 multi-genre films, gala events, and award ceremonies. In Edmonton, also known as Canada's Festival City, visitors flock to the Edmonton International Fringe Theatre Festival and the Edmonton Folk Music Festival. Whichever festivals you attend, you can count on enjoying a stimulating cultural experience.

NATIONAL PARKS

Five of Alberta's regional parks comprise a UNESCO World Heritage site. Two of the most popular are Banff National Park and Jasper National Park. Banff National Park is Canada's first-founded national park and home to an outstanding variety of geological and ecological features—mountains, glaciers, ice fields, lakes, alpine meadows, mineral hot springs, and canyons. The park is also known for its diverse wildlife. Visitors can encounter 53 species of mammals, including bighorn sheep, wolves, bears, elk, coyotes, caribou, and even mountain lions. Jasper National Park is a great place for camping, hiking, swimming, fishing, boating, bicycling, horseback riding, cross-country and downhill skiing, ice-skating, and snowboarding.

COLUMBIA ICEFIELD GLACIERS

The Columbia Icefield is located on the boundary of Banff and Jasper national parks. One of the largest accumulations of ice and snow south of the Arctic Circle, it covers an area of nearly 83 square miles. The continuous accumulation of snow feeds eight major glaciers, including the Athabasca, Dome, and Stutfield glaciers, all visible from Icefields Parkway. The most easily accessible glacier flowing from the massive Columbia Icefield, the Athabasca Glacier is the most visited glacier in North America. Take a ride out onto the surface of the glacier in a specially built all-terrain Ice Explorer. It's a truly once-in-a-lifetime experience.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

THE TRAVEL SMART PLAN® PROGRAM:

The following is a brief summary of our two-part Travel Smart Plan. Section I describes the Change & Cancellation Waiver provided by Classic Vacations, LLC, and Section II provides information about the Travel Insurance benefits underwritten by Arch Insurance Company, Jersey City, NJ.

SECTION I — Provided by Classic Vacations, LLC.

With the purchase of the waiver, you are protected against:

TRIP CANCELLATION: In the event of cancellation prior to departure, Classic Vacations will refund 100% of the amounts paid for hotel, rental car, ground transfer, refundable airline reservations, and destination activity reservations.

TRIP CHANGE: If a trip is changed prior to departure, Classic Vacations will waive all change fees imposed by car rental companies, ground transfer providers, and destination activity suppliers, and up to two (2) change fees imposed by airlines for published fare reservations.

TERMS & CONDITIONS: By making a deposit or paying in full for your Classic Vacations Canada vacation, you acknowledge and agree to the terms and conditions as set forth below.

RESERVATIONS: Contact your Travel Advisor.

PAYMENTS: For all bookings made forty-five (45) days or more prior to departure, a minimal deposit per person is required by Classic Vacations within five (5) days of making your reservation unless otherwise noted. If your deposit is not received by Classic Vacations within five (5) days or by a specified option date, your booking will be automatically canceled. Final payment is due forty-five (45) days prior to departure in most cases. Full payment is due immediately for bookings made within forty-five (45) days of departure unless otherwise noted. Hotels may require full payment at the time of booking for high-demand periods. Generally, villas, yachts, and private jets require a fifty (50) percent deposit at the time of booking. Most published airfares require full payment and immediate ticketing.
